**Brief Synopsis of Day 1** (see attached agenda/schedule for further details; to be attached)/July 29, 2019

The 150<sup>th</sup> session of the Georgia, North Region Annual Conference was held July 29-31, 2019 at Atlanta Evergreen Marriott Conference Resort, 4021 Lakeview Drive, Stone Mountain, Georgia. The conference was hosted by the Atlanta-Rome District with Rev. Christopher Waller, Pastor, Butler Street CME Church serving as Host Pastor and respectively, Presiding Elder Dr. Jerry D. Woodfork, Sr., serving as Host Presiding Elder. The conference began with the Morning Meditation led by Rev. Montavious Brinson (Pastor, Trinity CME, Toccoa, GA, Elberton-Gainesville District) and the meditation speaker: Reverend Dr. Gwendolyn Smith (Retired). The Sermon Text was John 3:16 and Sermon Topic: "A Loving God." Official Opening of the conference began at 9:00 am with Presiding Elder Rev. Dr. Jerry Woodfork, Sr. presenting the Presiding Prelate of the Sixth Episcopal District, The Right Reverend Dr. Thomas L. Brown, Sr. The agenda followed as outlined: Conference Organization, A "Moth" Speech: Local Worship, The Bishop Speaks: "Back to Basics: Going Out", Conference Relations (Disciplinary Questions 1-23) and the Saints Beyond the River Service.

Recommendations for Statisticians preceded as follows: Rev. Stephen J. Delaine, Statistician and Mrs. Lunita Mayfield/Mrs. Sonia Edmond, Assistant Secretary. The motion carried. The additional recommendations were made with the motion being carried: Ms. Jackie Payton, Pension Clerk; Orderlies: Rev. Jimrekis Allen, Rev. Jacqueline Horne, Rev. William Sunkett; Christian Index: Mrs. Mary Watts, Mrs. JoAnn Bryant, Rev. Larry Edmond; Missionary Messenger: Mrs. Betty Hamilton, Mrs. Bridgette Jackson, Mrs. Clide Coppin.

Following Bishop Brown's Bishop Speaks Message, the Ministerial Examination came forth to present Disciplinary Questions 1-23, Conference Relations. Upon completion, the conference Business Session adjourned for the Memorial Service. Deceased preachers, Layman, Missionaries and Ministers' Spouses, as applicable, were. The Celebration Saints Beyond the River Worship Leader and Speaker were respectively: Rev. Dr. C.M. Waller, Butler Street CME Church, Atlanta, GA and Rev. Eddie S. Thornton, Flat Rock CME Church, Elberton, GA. The Morning Session was adjourned.

The afternoon conference session reconvened for the afternoon and proceeded with continuation of Disciplinary Questions 1-23, Conference Relations and Pastoral Reports from the following districts: Augusta-Sparta, Elberton-Gainesville, Atlanta-Rome, GA. Upon completion, the session was adjourned to prepare for Holy Communion. The Worship Leader and Speaker for Holy Communion follows: Presiding Elder Dr. Jerry D. Woodfork, Sr and Retired Bishop, Bishop Othal H. Lakey. Bishop Lakey's Sermon Text and Topic is as follows: Text: Mark 7:24-30; Topic: "The Time Jesus Lost the Argument about Who Should Take Communion."

Guest: Commissioner Barry Johnson, DeKalb County; The Honorable Michael Thurmond, CEO Dekalb County, Dr. Henry Love Whelchel, Retired Distinguished ITC Professor; Rep. Billy Mitchell, State Representative, State of Georgia.

**Brief Synopsis of Day 2** (see attached agenda/schedule for further details)/July 30, 2019

The day began with Morning Meditation, which was led by Reverend Stephen J. Delaine, Linden Shorts CME Church, Atlanta-Rome District. Reverend Gregory Williams, Pastor of the Power Community CME Church, Atlanta-Rome, Georgia was the speaker. The Sermon Text and Topic follows: Text: John 12:32; Topic: "Will Somebody Give Jesus A Lift". Upon completion, Presiding Elder Frederick L. Braddock came forth to introduce the Presiding Prelate of the Georgia, North Region, the Right Reverend Dr. Thomas L. Brown, Sr. Following, the Committee on Minutes came forth to present their report. Members of the Committee reporting: Peggy Cureton (Elberton-Gainesville District) and Annie Horne (Atlanta-Rome District). The committee reported that minutes from the first session of the 150<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference Session of the Georgia, North Region had been reviewed and were found to be proper and in order; requiring no corrections. A motion from the committee was made to accept the minutes presented with no corrections from the first day session. The motion carried. Proceeding the Committee on Minutes report, Bishop Brown presented his second Bishop Speaks A "Moth" Speeches ensued: Local Church Evangelism presented by Rev. Leon Moore, Jr., General Secretary of Evangelism & Mission and Pastor of Hickory Grove CME Church (Elberton-Gainesville District) 21<sup>st</sup> Century Local Church Discipleship Development presented by Rr. Curtis L. West, Jr., Presiding Elder, North-Columbus-LaGrange District and Pastor of Holsey Chapel CME Church (West Georgia Region). The Joint Board of Finance was called forth to receive monies from the 2018-2019 Faith Pledges and accept 2019-2020 Faith Pledge commitments from members of the Annual Conference. The session was adjourned to prepare for the Celebration and Thanksgiving Worship Service; whereby Presiding Elder Willie J. Wiley served as Worship Leader and the speaker was Presiding Elder Jane E. Thomas, Fort Valley – Savannah District (Central Georgia). The Sermon Text and Topic follows: Text: 1 Peter 1:3-9; Topic: "A Living Hope". The Morning Session was adjourned after the Worship Service.

Upon reconvening for the afternoon Business Conference Session; Rev. Dr. Henry Love Whelchel, Jr. came forth to present a session entitled "The Legacy of the CME Church for this Generation." The following reports were provided: Women's Missionary Society presented by Betty Christian, Region President; Board of Christian Education presented by Jackie Carter, Region Board of Christian Education Director and Lay presented by Gregory Lewis, Sr. Region Lay Leader. A motion was carried to appoint Gregory Lewis as Lay Leader for the ensuing (2019-2020) conference year. It is noted that Jackie Carter was appointed Sixth Episcopal District Missionary Institute Coordinator. Presiding Elder Jerry D. Woodfork, Jr. came forth and presented report from the Board of Trustees. Motions were made to close the following CME Churches: Walker Chapel CME (Augusta-Sparta District) and Arnold Chapel CME Church (Elberton-Gainesville District). Pursuant to Paragraph 602.6 of the Book of Discipline, Presiding Elder of the respective Districts PE Willie J. Wiley and PE Frederick L. Braddock, Sr., came forth to present to the conference rationale and information to support the closings of the church. Upon receiving reports from the Presiding Elders, motions were carried to accept the recommendations to close the named churches. PE Dr. Jerry D. Woodfork stated the Board of Trustees will follow through on all required actions to officially close and present a report of status during the upcoming Winter Council, which will be held in December 2019.

Presiding Elder Dr. Donald R. Jordan, PE Macon-Barnesville District and Pastor of New St. Paul and Bethel CME Churches, came forth to present the final "Moth" Speech entitled Local Church Stewardship.

**Brief Synopsis of Day 2** (see attached agenda/schedule for further details)/July 30, 2019P

Proceeding the Moth Talk other reports received, the 2019-2020 Georgia, North Region Budget was presented by Joint Board of Finance Chair, Rev. Dr. Herman Skip Mason. The budget was adopted by the Annual Conference as presented. Upon completion, Rev. Dr. James E. Clements, Treasurer, came forth and presented the Region Treasurer's Report. The annual conference, through a motion that carried, accepted the Treasurer's report as presented. The minutes also reflect Bishop Thomas L. Brown's decision that forty percent (40%) of proceeds

from the One in the Spirit Banquet will allocated to the local churches to assist with needed repairs, etc. Bishop Brown's goal is to provide more to assist local churches of the region.

The members stated that they and the pastor have physically canvassed the Norwood community and determined that there are no people available or willing to join the church on a permanent basis. They stated that people who are members of other churches in the community visit with them on some Sundays and special occasions. For instance, there were about 11 people present on the date of this Quarterly Conference with only three of them being members. The three members of Walker Chapel live in Augusta and confess that they were hanging on in attendance because of their father's and mother's loyalty to the church. However, an aging mother, their failure to attract new members, the church's distance from their homes, the work and resources required to maintain the facility all negatively contribute to their concerns and frustration. Following a discussion about Walker Chapel's survivability and their ability to maintain it, the three members proposed closing the church at the end of this year. The mother, Mrs. Claudine Nicely expressed concern about the Pastor's welfare as a result of the recommendation but was assured that the Bishop assigns pastors based on needs of the church. The Quarterly Conference was asked to vote on the recommendation to end worship at Walker Chapel CME church and close the building at the end of the current conference year. The Quarterly Conference unanimously approved the recommendation to close Walker Chapel CME Church effective June 2016 pending approval of the Annual Conference of the Georgia North Region of the Sixth Episcopal District. Sister Jannette Nicely (Trustee) was instructed to pay the insurance on the building to the date of closure. Presiding Elder Wiley asked to be informed before May 31, 2016 if the group reconsidered their decision. Otherwise, their recommendation to suspend worship at Walker Chapel CME Church will be a recommendation to the Annual Conference in June 2016. After collecting the reports and commending the members for their faithfulness the meeting was adjourned by presiding Elder Wiley.
