Pursuant to paragraph 602.6 (2) of the aforementioned reference, we are recommending that Walker Chapel CME located at 1170 Old Greensboro Road of Norwood, Georgia be closed due to lack of members and inoccupancy. The last three permanent members and previous Pastor met with the Presiding Elder Wiley at a Quarterly Conference in March 2016 (see attached minutes). The members stated that they were unable to sustain membership at the church and decided to remain in Augusta, their home area. The rejected relocating at Miles or any CME Church in Augusta based on a commitment to support a family-initiated worship center.

In 2017 an attempt was made to revitalize the church with a volunteer pastor but the location of the church and historical lack of support in attendance were not conducive to rekindling interest. Due to the fact that Walker Chapel has remained unoccupied for the previous year I am recommending that the church be permanently closed effective July 2019.

March 23,2016

Presiding Elder Willie J. Wiley convened the fourth Quarterly Conference at Walker Chapel at 1:20pm on March 23, 2016. The following persons were present Pastor Montavious Brinson, Sisters Alvinia Liowns (Steward), Jannete Nicely (Trustee), and Claudine Nicely (Stewardess). The members had prepared all required reports and were complimentary of the work that the pastor is doing in spite of no increase in membership from the three attending. The members stated that they and the pastor have physically canvassed the Norwood community and determined that there are no people available or willing to join the church on a permanent basis. They stated that people who are members of other churches in the community visit with them on some Sundays and special occasions. For instance, there were about 11 people present on the date of this Quarterly Conference with only three of them being members. The three members of Walker Chapel live in Augusta and confess that they were hanging on in attendance because of their father's and mother's loyalty to the church. However, an aging mother, their failure to attract new members, the church's distance from their homes, the work and resources required to maintain the facility all negatively contribute to their concerns and frustration. Following a discussion about Walker Chapel's survivability and their ability to maintain it, the three members proposed closing the church at the end of this year. The mother, Mrs. Claudine Nicely expressed concern about the Pastor's welfare as a result of the recommendation but was assured that the Bishop assigns pastors based on needs of the church. The Quarterly Conference was asked to vote on the recommendation to end worship at Walker Chapel CME church and close the building at the end of the current conference year. The Quarterly Conference unanimously approved the recommendation to close Walker Chapel CME Church effective June 2016 pending approval of the Annual Conference of the Georgia North Region of the Sixth Episcopal District. Sister Jannette Nicely (Trustee) was instructed to pay the insurance on the building to the date of closure. Presiding Elder Wiley asked to be informed before May 31, 3016 if the group reconsidered their decision. Otherwise, their recommendation to suspend worship at Walker Chapel CME Church will be a recommendation to the Annual Conference in June 2016. After collecting the reports and commending the members for their faithfulness the meeting was adjourned by presiding Elder Wiley.
